

Flowering Groundcover Garden

Neat, low-care design for a sunny front yard



Description

This simple design for a sunny front yard combines a large swath of a flowering groundcover ceanothus with an accent planting of a tall, structural grass against a boulder. It looks neat and attractive the year round with minimal watering and maintenance.

Plant List

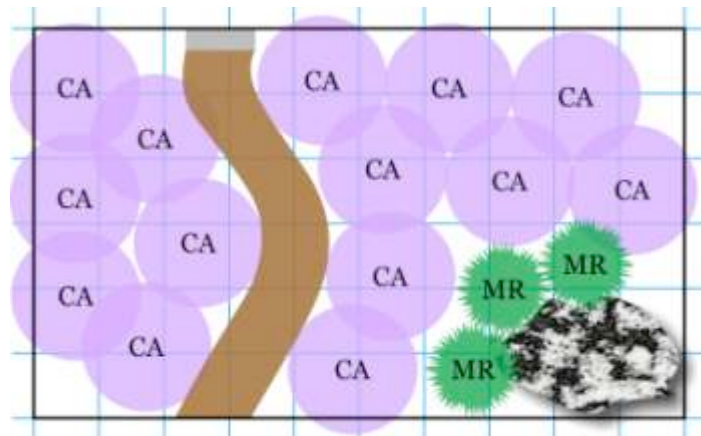
- CA Anchor Bay Ceanothus
(*Ceanothus gloriosus* 'Anchor Bay')
- MR Deergrass (*Muhlenbergia rigens*)

Region

All parts of California except deserts or above 4,000'

Site Conditions

- Exposure: Sun
Water: Dry
Soil: Any



Each square is 3' x 3'

Care & Maintenance

Deergrass should be cut to the ground in December every 3-4 years or whenever it starts looking ragged. Optionally, the ceanothus can be trained to a lower height than its natural habit of up to 2' by consistent pruning of upright branches.
