Archaeological Resources Conservation Statement

I _____ have been informed through participation in this Archaeological Seminar that:

- 1) "archaeological resources" as defined by the Archaeological Resources Protection Act (ARPA) of 1979 (Public Law 96-95 and as amended, 16 United States Code 470 aa – mm, 43 Code of Federal Regulations Part 7 [<http://www.nps.gov/archeology/tools/Laws/arpa.htm>]) are protected from excavation, removal, damage, alteration or defacement unless authorized by a permit from the Federal Land Manager;
- 2) ARPA prohibits making information available to the public concerning the nature and location of any archaeological resource unless the Federal land manager concerned determines that such disclosure (1) further the purposes of this Act or the Act of June 27,1960 [the Reservoir Salvage Act, as amended, 16 U.S.C. 469- 469c-1] and (2) does not create a risk of harm to such resources or to the site at which such resources are located, and that;
- 3) each Federal land manager is required to establish a program to increase public awareness of the significance of the archaeological resources located on public lands and Indian lands and the need to protect such resources.
