on the Infrastructure projects currently underway in the Park: North Evergreen Infrastructure Project is on schedule, phase 1 of Staff Housing Project is behind schedule, Red Rock Canyon Project is complete, Cameron Lake Day Use Area Project is on Schedule, and the Chief Mountain Highway Paving is proceeding well. The rational for the road closure on the Cameron Lake Highway was discuss. Parks felt this was the best course of action to accommodate the heavy construction traffic and the need to finish the project in 2016.

The Duplex project was discussed and Ken Black expressed his willingness to assist with construction management. Ken Black provided Council with a financial review of Crooked Creek Campground and the Duplex Project. He informed Council that revised testing of the water well at Crooked Creek Campground has been submitted to Alberta Environment.

Municipal Government Act Review Meeting

Chair Brian Reeves reported on his attendance at the Municipal Government Act review meeting in Lethbridge. He provide Council with and overview of the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework component is the revised Act. Brian Reeves also reported on his discussion with Minister Danielle Larivee on the Resort Communities Initiative and the remove of Improvement District No. 4 Waterton Lakes National Park from the Final Report submitted to the Province regarding Resort Communities' special needs. Council discussed the situation and felt it would be beneficial to set-up a meeting with Minister Danielle Larivee regarding Improvement District No. 4's status as a Resort Community.
