Adoption of Agenda

Presentation of RCMP – Mark Harrison

Other than the fire and premature closing of the park, 2017 was a good year. The RCMP Barracks renovations are being held up due to security issues but should be proceeding this summer. The RCMP will provide full coverage from June – August this year but only three officers will be available until June. Open area cannabis smoking was discussed.

Parks Canada Report – Bob Elliot, Town Site Manager

Bob Elliot reported:

- New superintendent has been assigned for a short period of time. He heads the cannabis committee.
- Parks has started cleanup of contaminated sites. Among those sites started
 is Alpine Stable, Visitor Centre, the Woodshop at Prince of Wales Hotel &
 Canyon Church Camp.
- There is a summer offer on trails that is available on the website. Possibly Bertha Falls & Lakefront trail.
- With regards to the water systems, they will do more testing than usual due to possible increased heavy metals in the water. AHS says that new backpacking filtration systems should be sufficient to clean the contaminated water supply.

Destination Marketing Organization (DMO)

Councillor Brian Reeves suggested that ID4 look into becoming a DMO to help with marketing and tourism for Waterton. This is supported as a Government Alberta program. Organizations must have at least one paid employee in order to qualify.

Alberta SouthWest Regional Alliance

Travel Alberta to put \$400,000 towards a marketing campaign in the Castle Mountain/Waterton Park area in 2018.

There is a grant that we are now on the short list for where we will have an electrical outlet for charging electric cars.

Waterton Springs Campground will be closed until at least August. A sale is going forward between Alberta Parks & the Nature Conservancy but it is a slow, drawn out process.

Highway 3 Economic Development Initiative

Councillor Brian Reeves reported that this organization did a strategic planning session recently & Alberta SouthWest Regional Alliance joined in the discussions to provide professional help in doing so.

Mayors and Reeves Meeting

STARS helipad in Raymond was closed and the question was raised if the current helipad found in the park was sufficient for STARS use. Bob Elliot, Town Site Manager said he would look into this.
