# **Delegation: Sgt. Mark Harrison**

There will be 4 RCMP members assigned to the Waterton area as of May 9. There will be an open house at the Waterton RCMP Station on May 10. RCMP Station is in need of some repairs, inside and out. They also want to put up a sign about the history of the building. There are also trees that need to be removed, this will need to be discussed with Parks Canada. Discussed the possibility of patrolling over the winter months, they are trying to find the resources to help with this.

### **Delegation: Parks Canada Representative, Ifan Thomas**

Ifan Thomas came to discuss the concerns about the new visitor center. After doing a study about the best possible location for this, they have come up with 2 options, but the grass field is the best area for this. Council was invited to meet with the staff architects to discuss conceptual designs. Parks Canada wants to enhance the playground area with the addition of the visitor centre. The building could possible integrate the theatre, therefore leaving that area as greenspace. Various ideas were discussed. Concerns of safety were also discussed. Council was concerned by the statement that all of council was in approval of this, when they did not approve or disapprove of the visitor centre. Council will meet with the Parks Canada architect on May 19 to discussed conceptual designs.
