Parks Canada Report – Bob Elliot, Town Site Manager

Bob Elliot reported:

- That the Contribution Agreement has been signed with the Waterton Park Community Association for the replacement of the spray park and playground.
- That an Avalanche Hazard has been issued on South Evergreen and the area is closed for public access. Parks Canada is experiencing a problem with people complying with the closure.
- So far in April the Park has received over 80cm of snow.
- Post Fire Recovery is significantly behind schedule due to the weather.
 Many of the damaged site have been assessed for hazards and reclamation work is beginning.
- Parks Canada's Executive Committee recently visited Waterton include the Chief Executive Officer Daniel Watson
- Announcements will be made shortly regarding the areas of the Park that will be open and closed this summer.

Meeting with Parks Canada's CEO

Councillor Brian Baker reported that he met with Parks Canada's CEO Daniel Watson. The meeting was very positive where Daniel Watson indicated the Waterton is currently Parks Canada's top priority and will be their investment focus for the next several years. Councillor Baker provided an overview of the ID and Joint Venture. Daniel Waston indicated that the ID was very innovative and should be proud of their collaboration initiatives.

Committee Reports

Clean Lake Initiative

Chair Jody Thaell reported that the Committee has had some very positive meetings with Parks Canada. They will be releasing information once the implementation path is confirmed. Parks Canada is not prepared to allow a piecemeal opening of the lake. That the most important consideration is the protection of the water. The Committee is working on a simple, safe, and cost-effective approach with no threat of contamination. Chair Thaell indicate it is very unlikely if not impossible for a 2018 opening. That the Committee is working towards 2019.



Medical Services Committee

Chair Jody Thaell reported that a meeting has been arranged on May 7th with the Honourable Sarah Hoffman, Deputy Premier and Minster of Health to share information about medical services in Waterton. Chair Thaell indicated that Waterton has over ½ a million visitors annually and that the Park needs more Provincial Health presence.
