...using organic, sustainable methods

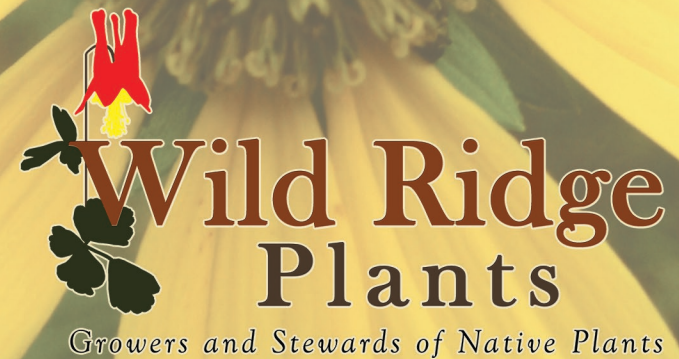
...with many edible, medicinal, and permaculture species

Native Plant Nursery

Our plants are **nursery-propagated** from **seed hand-collected** from **local wild populations**. We use an organic, peat-free potting mix, only organic fertilizers, and water-conserving practices.

We focus on native plants for ecological restoration, home gardens, permaculture, and herbal uses.

Stewardship Services

We give **presentations** and **guided walks** on plant ecology, edible and medicinal plants, restoration, and horticulture for both general and professional audiences.



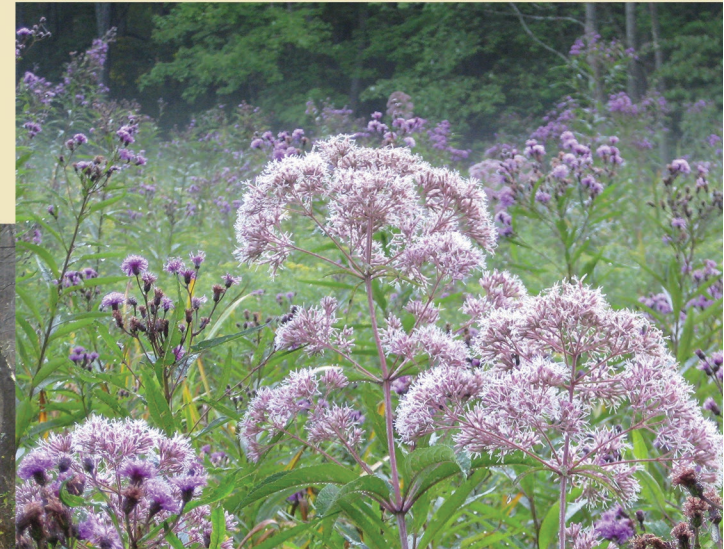
