As the former co-founder and artistic director of the revolutionary dance companies Pilobolus and Momix, Alison Chase has created more than 50 works for the stage that have been seen by audiences around the world for over 35 years. Through dance performance and dance making, Alison Chase/Performance seeks to engage and inform audiences in its home community of Brooksville and throughout New England.

The Atlantic Clarion Steel Band has been in continuous existence since its founding in 1974 in Brooksville, Maine, by Carl Chase. For over 40 years, the band has performed throughout the northeastern United States at festivals, concerts and parties. In the process they have inspired and encouraged dozens of steel band programs in schools and communities from Maine to New York. Nigel Chase has been director of the Atlantic Clarion Steel Band since 2009 and is a preeminent proponent of the steel pan and its music. Performer, arranger, teacher, and director of the thriving steel band community in and around Blue Hill, Nigel has developed pan programs for youth in schools, churches, and now through his own Pan Institute in Blue Hill Maine.
