This former church is now available as a Performing Arts Center and as a facility for family and community events.

Features:

Main Floor Performance Venue - Seating for 80+ persons.

- Adjustable stage lighting.
- Sound system available; ask for this if needed.
- > Normally configured for performance events; different configurations possible.
- > New, more comfortable seating is being acquired (available in September)!
- > Handicap accessibility for the Main Entrance.

Lower level Community Room - Space and tables available for seating of 60+.

- Kitchen facility with sink, fridge, 4-burner range, microwave, coffee makers, storage and counter space.
- > Ceiling LED room lighting, or floor lamps for mood lighting.
- Side Entrance door for stairway access; ask for use of the elevator if needed.

Rental options (per day): Main Floor \$100, Community Room, \$100, both \$200.

- Ideal space for weddings, family gatherings, reunions, performance events, adult education, music or dance lessons, presentations, lectures.
- > Rental for less than a full day can be negotiated. Consult with the Manager.
- Assured year-round comfort with heat pumps for cooling in summer; heat pumps with a forced hot air heating system for winter warmth.
- Two rest rooms: one handicap-accessible rest room in the lower level, a second rest room at the side entrance level.
- Parking space for up to eleven vehicles, with additional space in summer on lawn areas and along Hancock Avenue.

Some catering services may also be available by FoSML volunteers. Ask for details, if interested.
