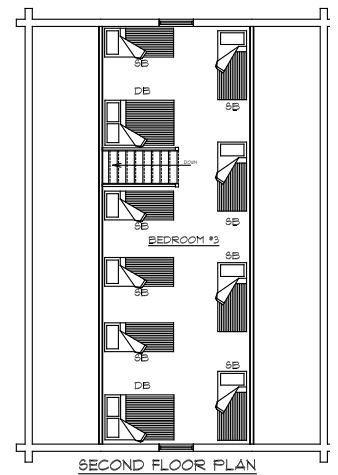
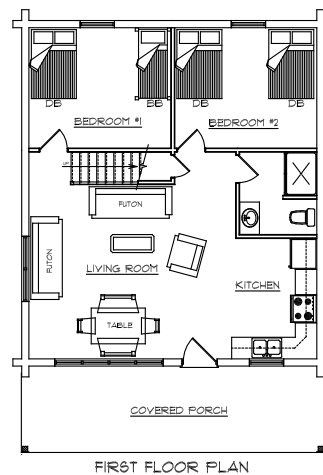
Bigelow Cabins

Located in Bingham, Maine. The "Bigelow" cabins are 600 sq. ft. and sleep 2-8 guests, with a 2 guest minimum on weekdays, 4 guest and two night stay minimum on weekends. The cabins have two bedrooms, living room, dining area, kitchen, bathroom, shower, cable, DVD, Wi-Fi, ADA compliant and are on one floor. Weekday minimums apply on weekends if you purchase a rafting and meals package.



Kennebec Cabins

Located in Bingham, Maine. The "Kennebec" cabins are 1500 sq. ft. and sleep 6-24 guests, with a 6 guest minimum on weekdays and 8 guests and a two night minimum on weekends. These cabins have two bedrooms on the first floor with two double beds in each, living room with two double futons, dining area, kitchen, bathroom, shower, cable, DVD and Wi-Fi. The second floor has eight twin beds, two double beds and three cots. Weekday minimums apply on weekends if you purchase rafting and meals package.

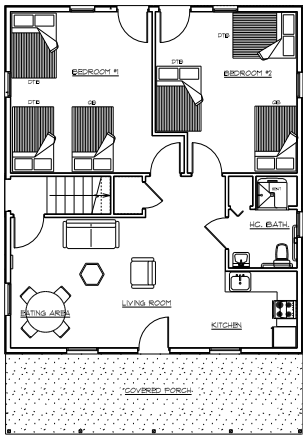




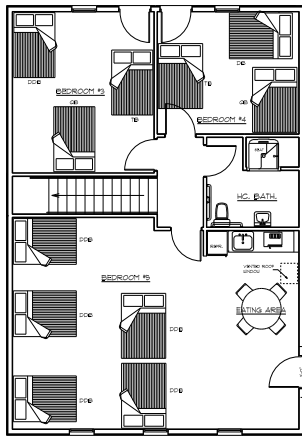

Flagstaff Cabins

Located in Bingham, Maine. The Flagstaff cabins are our largest cabins (2300 square feet), they are built on two floors - 30x34 first floor and 30x42 on the second floor and sleep 12-36 guests per cabin. The first floor has two bedrooms - each bedroom has one queen bed and two double/twin bunk beds, living room, dining area, full kitchen, bathroom, shower, cable, DVD, Wi-Fi and are ADA compliant.

The second floor has three bedrooms – one bedroom has one queen bed, one double bed and one twin bed; the second bedroom has one queen bed, one double/twin bunk and one twin; the third bedroom has five double/double bunk beds. On the second floor, there is a living and dining area, efficiency kitchen (sink, full size refrigerator, microwave and coffee maker, utensils and place settings) and bathroom with a shower.

The cabin has a front porch with a roof, outside fireplace and grill. The minimum is 8 guests on weekdays, twelve guests and a two night minimum on weekends. (Friday, Saturday and long weekends). Weekday minimums apply on weekends if you purchase rafting and meals package.

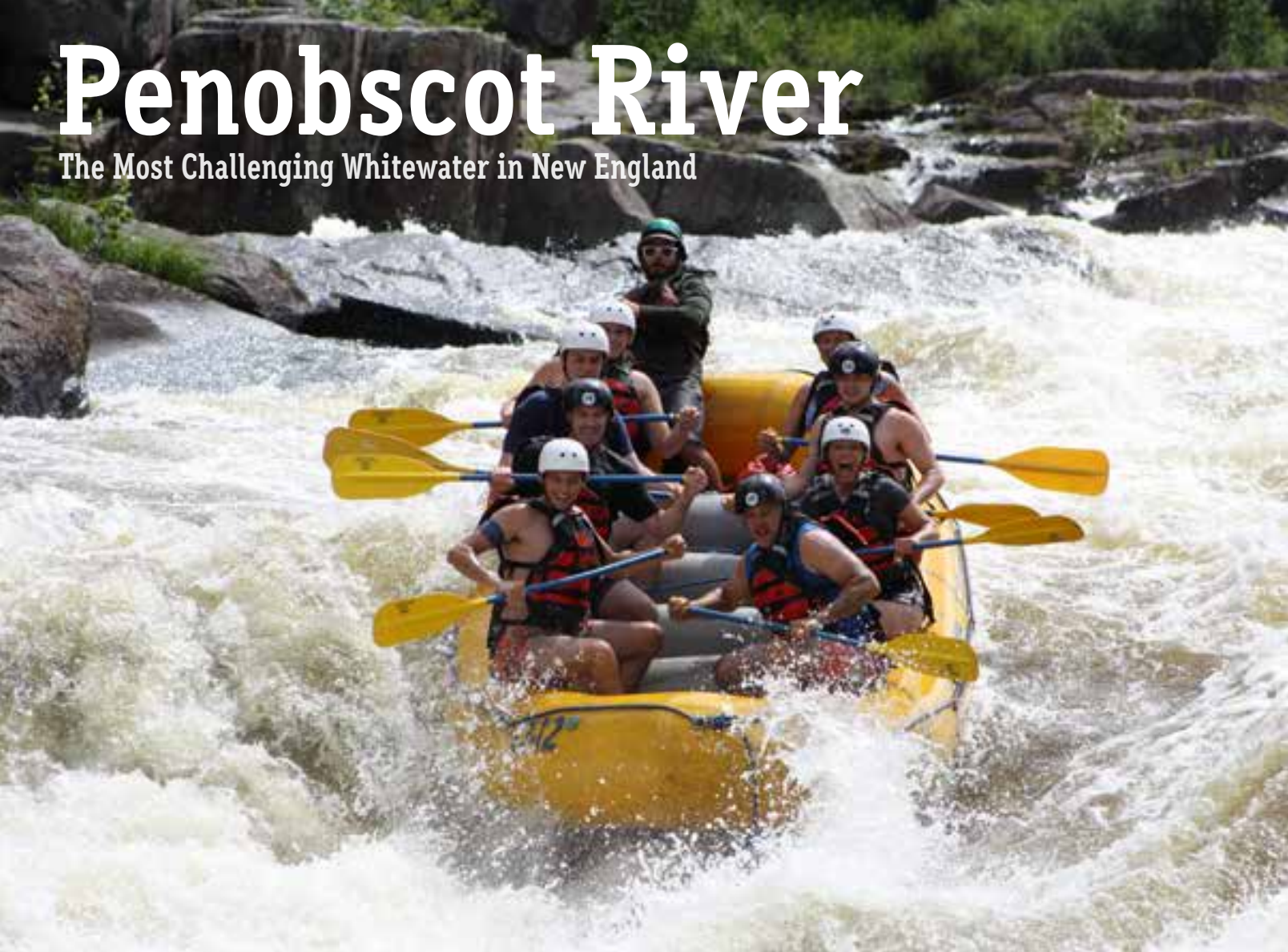

The Most Challenging Whitewater in New England

The Penobscot is the most technically challenging river in Maine and one of the best in the United States. You will experience technical rapids, exposed rocks, steeper gradients and awesome whitewater.

The river is set in the shadow of mile high Mt. Katahdin and on the perimeter of Baxter State Park. Eagle, osprey, moose and bear sightings are not uncommon, while the river abounds with salmon and trout.

TRIPS OFFERED ON THE PENOBSCOT:

PENOBSCOT "FULL RIVER TRIP" – Run the more moderate Lower Section in the morning and the more challenging Upper Gorge in the afternoon, this trip runs every rapid on the river and floats by mile high Mt. Katahdin. Minimum age is 12 years (includes all rapids); 10 years (excludes class 5 sections); 5 years (excludes class 3 - 5 sections).

PENOBSCOT "ULTIMATE" – Run the Upper Gorge two times – this trip focuses on the Class 5 Upper Section and does not run the Lower Section. Minimum group size requirement or join an existing trip. Minimum age is 12 years.

PENOBSCOT "TWO DAY TRIP" – Treat yourself to one of our best trips. Raft the Full River Trip on day one and the Ultimate on day two. Each day begins and ends at our Penobscot River base, camping and lodging is available on site or through local establishments. 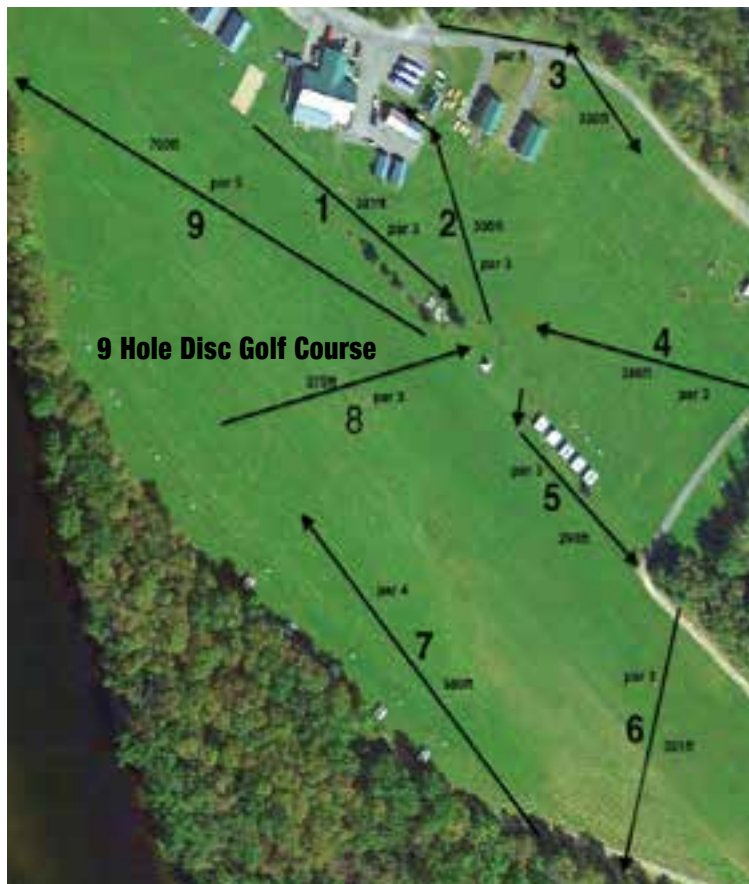

North Country Rivers base complex is located in the upper Kennebec Valley Region of Maine. Known for having the best ATV trail system in the East, this region also contains some of the most beautiful and pristine wilderness in the US.

Maine's ATV Trail System is made up of thousands of miles of designated trails – stretching to Canada.

Our base complex in Bingham, Maine, is on the Maine ATV trail system. This portion extends north to the Forks and Jackman (and on to Canada), west to Rangeley Lakes, and northeast to Moosehead Lake (and Katahdin). This trail, and many feeder trails, provide hundreds of miles of open terrain, incredible scenery and awesome riding for all skill levels.

Many options for single and multi-day loop trips exist that begin and end at our base complex. When you rent one of our cozy log cabins on the Kennebec River, you will be able to return from any trip, and park your ATV right at your front door! 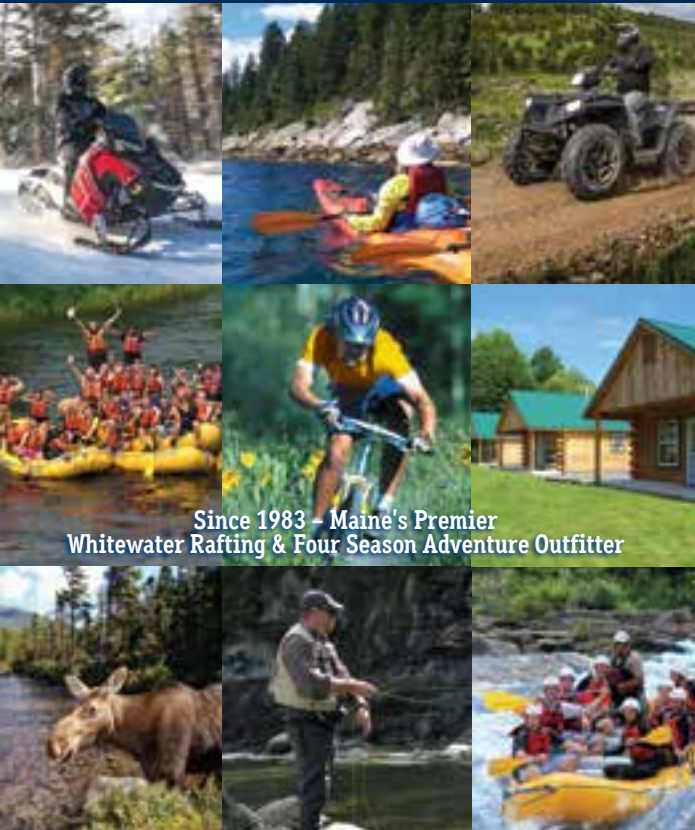
