5. Tazewell historic area - dining, antiques, classic gas station from Thunder Road movie
6. Tazewell Civil War drive
7. New Tazewell - local music, dining, shops
8. Big Spring Church ca 1795
9. Kyles Ford Riverplace - dining, general store, education center, camping, cabins, wildlife center; hub of Melungeon culture; Horan's store; Sneedville - home of bluegrass great, Jimmy Martin
10. Norris Lake - boating, fishing, dining, lodging
11. Clinch Mountain Winery - local wines in a beautiful setting
12. Petticoat Junction - old fashioned general store with front stoop whittling
13. Joppa Pottery - local potters with a national reputation and national clientele
14. Town of Blaine - Clinch Mountain Bluegrass Festival
15. Landings at River's Edge
16. Town of Rutledge - historic buildings, shops, dining, tomato festival
17. Ritter Farms - local produce, dining, events, Back to the Farm
18. Windy Hill Farm - Tennessee Alpacas
19. Bean Station Civil War site
20. Town of Bean Station - dining, lodging, access to Cherokee Lake
21. German Creek Resort - lodging, boating, events, launching site for reservoir heritage tour
22. Lakeshore Drive agritourism and scenic route - local greenhouses, farms and other agri-businesses and campgrounds and marinas
23. Cherokee Lake Dam - TVA interpretive site, restrooms, picnic area, walking trails
24. Panther Creek State Park - swimming, boating, walking and hiking trails
25. Morristown - dining, full range of lodging options, historic neighborhoods, mall, shops, cultural events, live music, greenway walking trail, boyhood home of Davy Crockett, Civil War sites, parks, theatre, art shows, festivals
26. Great Smoky Mountains Exposition Center - horse shows, livestock shows, rodeos, and many other events, fun for locals and visitors alike
27. Village of White Pine - local dining and services
28. Historic Downtown Dandridge - dining, lodging, shops, historic walking tour, scenic drives, Davy Crockett history
29. Bush's Best Baked Bean Factory
30. Historic Downtown Newport - a riverside downtown with 1920s character, great local theatre company, good shops. Newport is the base camp for all outdoor adventures offered by the Great Smoky Mountains - whitewater rafting, hiking, camping, horseback riding and more.
31. Rankin Bottoms Wildlife Area - One of the most significant bird watching areas in the state. Declared Important Bird Area by the Audubon Society
32. Briarwood Ranch Safari Park, Bybee
33. Rafting - Twelve outfitters on the Pigeon River
34. Del Rio and the Christy Story - A hamlet echoing the places and people of the famous tale of a young woman who traveled into Appalachia as part of a mission program. Also hear live music in local venues and explore the surrounding Cherokee National Forest.

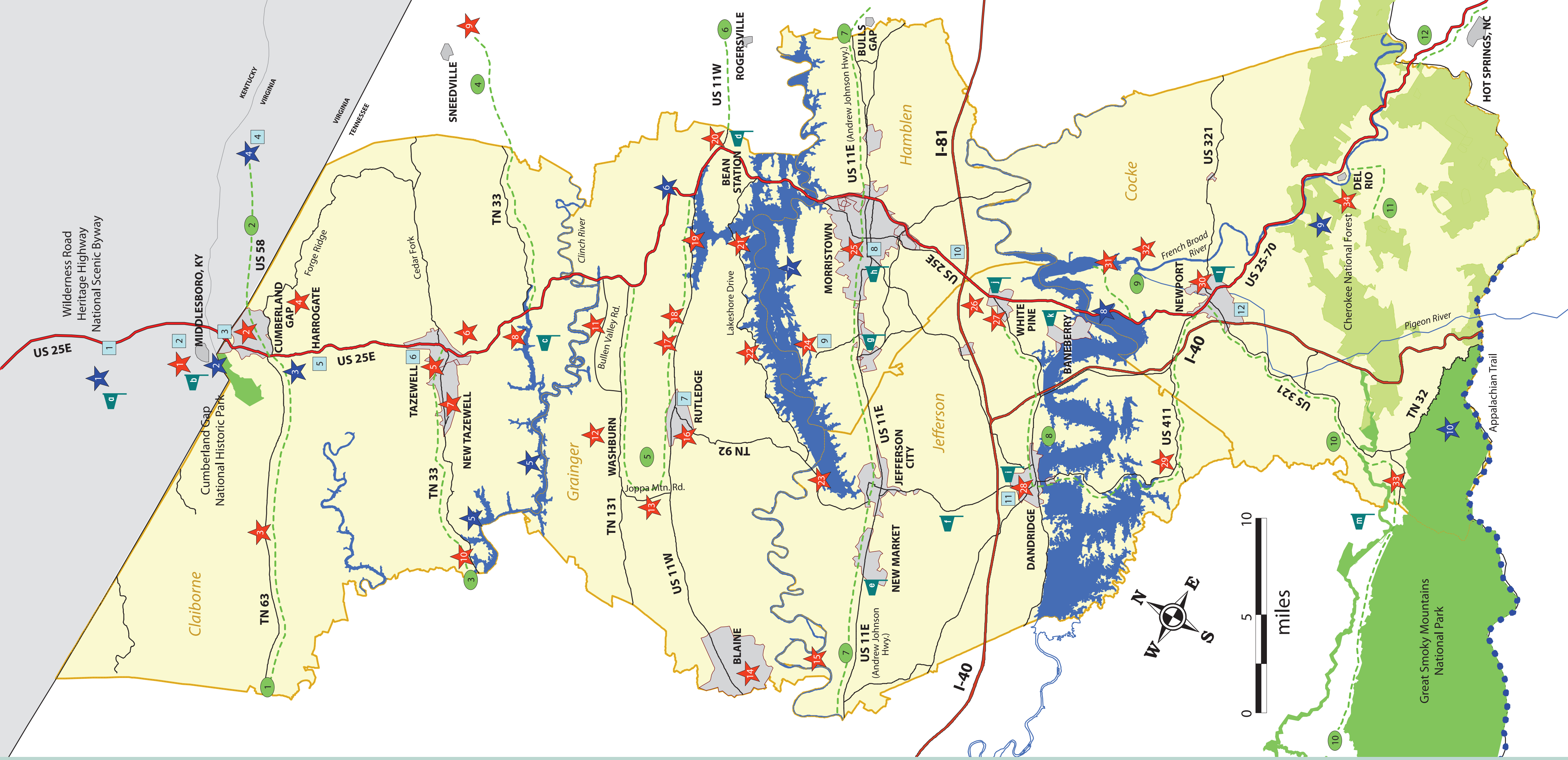
